Nutritious Meals Served Out of the CCO Kitchen

Through your generous giving, the CCO kitchen served 152,558 warm, nutritious meals in 2022. Families and individuals moving from one of Cornerstone's shelters into new housing receive ample groceries to stock their kitchens.

Cornerstone Food Pantry has offered canned goods, fresh fruit and vegetables, meat, bread, and other food items on a weekly basis. These services combat food insecurity and help shelter guests and neighbors reach their full potential.
