CCO operates three primary shelters: **Hannah, Sylvia, and Naomi**, in the Uptown neighborhood of Chicago. In 2026, the Haven on Lincoln will open as a fourth site.

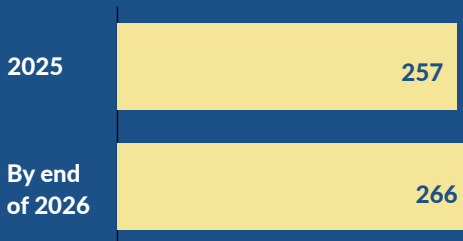
## A HISTORY OF SERVICE & PARTNERSHIP

### Cornerstone Community Outreach

was founded in 1989 to raise the quality of life for people experiencing homelessness. What began as a small, community-driven effort has since expanded to serve nearly 300 individuals and families each day, helping thousands move toward stable housing, employment, and long-term independence. Rooted in a commitment to dignity and access, CCO's work extends beyond housing. In partnership with the Greater Chicago Food Depository, the organization distributes more than 150,000 pounds of food annually to residents and neighbors facing food insecurity. Today, as one of Chicago's largest shelter providers, CCO continues to stand in the gap—ensuring that every person, regardless of circumstance, has access to safe shelter, nourishment, and the opportunity to rebuild their lives.

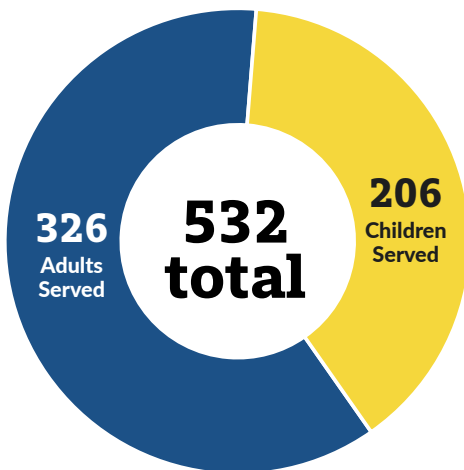

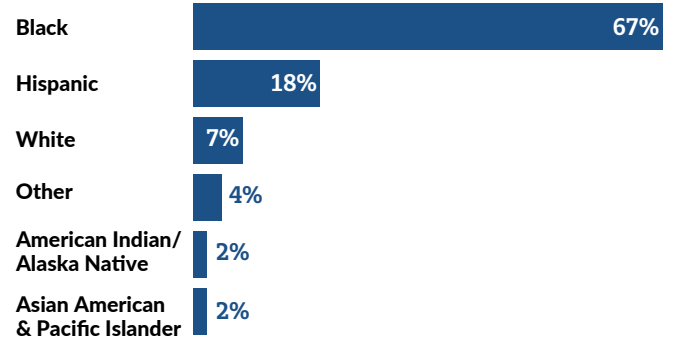

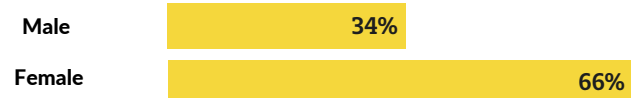

## WHAT'S NEXT

Building on core shelter operations, CCO will launch a Behavioral Health Clinic and a Medical Respite program by fall 2026. Together, these programs bring therapy, psychiatry, and healthcare directly to shelter residents. Co-locating this care and case management addresses the fragmentation individuals experiencing homelessness face. CCO believes in the effectiveness of this pathway—moving from crisis to stability—through this innovative, scalable model. Not only will CCO meet the needs of people experiencing homelessness, but it will also strengthen homelessness services across Chicago.



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
